As chief shepherd of the Archdiocese of Halifax-Yarmouth, I wish to extend a heartfelt thank you to those who so generously donated to the Marriage Tribunal.

In 2015, Pope Francis brought significant changes to the Office of the Marriage Tribunal and new reforms to the process of applying for a declaration of nullity with the implementation of *Mitis Iudex*.

The first notable response to this announcement was an immediate increase in the volume of applications and inquiries, which rose to 300% of the usual volume.

Coinciding with this change, and in keeping with the wishes of the Holy Father, Pope Francis, the Halifax-Yarmouth Branch Tribunal removed the previous fee for service and replaced it with a donation request as there are indeed expenses associated with the process that the diocese must cover.
