

Below are some sample intercessions that we invite parishes to include in their Prayers of the Faithful as we prepare for our first local Eucharistic Congress from October 17-20, 2024.

Included are intercessions that pray for the preparation and success of the Congress. There are also prayers that break open the theme: **Communion to heal the world,** that are categorized under the five ways the Eucharist can heal: **restore, unite, inspire, serve, and equip.**

Parishes are encouraged to include a few of these intercessions in their Prayers of the Faithful at their Masses leading up to October.
